Key Goals

## The Building Program

Design proposals must include the following components:

- Living Space: A flexible and comfortable living area that can accommodate individuals or small families.
- Sleeping Quarters: Efficient sleeping arrangements that ensure privacy and comfort.
- Kitchen Area: A functional kitchen that provides essential cooking facilities.
- Bathroom Facilities: Innovative solutions for hygiene and sanitation in a compact space.
- Storage Solutions: Smart storage systems to maximize the use of limited space.
- Outdoor Integration: Features that enhance the relationship between indoor and outdoor living, such as balconies, terraces, or retractable elements.

## **Project Proposal Requirements**

Participants must submit a project proposal that includes:

- A clear and compelling design narrative explaining the concept.
- Detailed floor plans, elevations, and sections that illustrate the spatial organization and functional layout.
- Renderings or visualizations that convey the aesthetic quality and experience.
- A site plan.

## Site

Participants are free to choose any site for their mobile home design, whether it be urban, rural, or natural landscapes. Designs should consider the following:

- Integration with the chosen environment, whether on wheels or as a temporary structure.
- Accessibility to utilities and resources.
- Potential impact on the site and surrounding community.

## Timeline

- Registration Opens: 1<sup>st</sup> October 2024
- Registration Deadline: 20<sup>th</sup> June 2025
- Submission Deadline: 25<sup>th</sup> June 2025
- Jury Evaluation: July 1<sup>st</sup> August 31<sup>st</sup> 2025
- Winners Announcement: September 25<sup>th</sup> 2025

## Submission Requirements

## File Format:

• All entries must be submitted as a single PDF document.

## Sheets:

- Minimum of 3 sheets, maximum of 6 sheets.
- Each sheet should include designs, drawings, and views that effectively communicate the project concept.

## Text Explanation:

• Each sheet must contain explanatory text that describes and supports your design decisions.

• Text should be clear and concise, highlighting the main ideas and features of the project.

## Content to Include (per sheet):

- Design Concepts: Conceptual drawings, diagrams, and sketches.
- Plans, Elevations, and Sections: Architectural plans, cross-sections, and elevations.
- Views and Renderings: 3D views, perspectives, or rendered images of the project.
- Diagrams: Illustrations explaining circulation, spatial relationships, environmental or structural concepts.

#### Resolution and Quality:

• All sheets should be high-quality, legible, and visually clear.

#### File Size:

• The total file size should not exceed 20 MB.

### Naming Convention:

• The file should be named as: CompetitionName\_ParticipationCode.pdf

## Anonymity:

• No names, logos, or identifying marks should appear on any of the submitted sheets to ensure anonymity during judging.
